I am happy to inform you that the University of Tennessee at Knoxville Horticultural Therapy courses have been granted accreditation by the American Horticultural Therapy Association. This accreditation is for a five year period beginning April 1, 2021 through March 31, 2026.

Until we design and implement subsequent accreditation reviews, it will be your responsibility to inform us of any changes in your program. If there are any staff and/or curriculum substitutions made prior to the five years, you need only submit for approval documentation noting the changes. A complete course description including content, credit hours, objectives and assessment tools for each new course and a resume for new staff members, must be submitted as documentation. There will be a \$100 fee for processing program changes.

You will be asked to submit a new application and fee eight weeks before your accreditation expires.
